	If someone is being considered for a church role with children or vulnerable adults, Safer Recruiting Guidance must be followed. If you have Permission to Officiate, the Diocese will handle your DBS and training.

Basic: All Church Officers (paid and voluntary) Foundation: Clergy, Readers, PtOs, PSOs, those working with children or vulnerable adults, PCC Members, Church Wardens.
